Body:

- I. Fellowship is a state into which we are called 1 Cor. 1:9.
 - A. How are we called into the state of fellowship 1 Th. 2:12-13; 2 Th. 2:13-14.
 - 1. Note the connection 1 Pet. 1:1-5; Heb. 10:19-22; 1 Pet. 3:21.
- II. Fellowship is linked to teaching and obedience —1 Jn. 1:3, 6-7.
 - A. That fact was demonstrated on the day of Pentecost.
 - 1. Peter preached Jesus Acts 2:14, 36.
 - 2. Fellowship was established Acts 2:40-42.
 - B. Consider those at Ephesus taught by Paul Acts 19:1-7.
 - C. Not only is fellowship linked with obedience, one must continue in that obedience 1 Jn. 1:6-7.
