- I. When time ends, Christ, the righteous judge will appear —
1 Cor. 15:22-24.
 - A. We know not when it will be — Matt. 24:36.
 - B. It will come unexpectedly — Matt. 24:37-39, 42.
- II. When time ends, every person will stand before Him.
 - A. Jesus said — Jn. 5:28-29;
 1. Paul adds — 2 Cor. 5:10.
 2. The picture was revealed unto John — Rev. 20:12.
 - B. Even the angels who sinned may be there — Jude 1:6.
- III. When time ends, every Person will glorify God.
 - A. We are to glorify God in the church — Eph. 3:20-21.
 - B. Most will never do that until time ends — Rom. 14:10-12.
- IV. When time ends, every work will be judged.
 - A. Everyone is there, and the books are opened — Rev. 20:12-13.
 - B. Solomon said it well — Eccl. 12:13-14.
 - C. Nothing will be hidden — Lk. 8:17; 2 Cor. 4:5.
 - D. The basis of judgment will be the truth of God's word —
Ps. 96:13; Jn. 12:48.
- V. When time ends, every person will enter eternity.
 - A. Those who had died will know their fate — e.g., Lk. 16:22-25.
 - B. The righteous will be separated from the unrighteous.
 1. Regarding the righteous —
Matt. 25:34; 1 Pet. 1:4; 2 Tim. 4:8
 2. Regarding the unrighteous —
Matt. 25:41; 2 Ths. 1:8-9; Matt. 25:46.
