I. They reacted to the resurrection by _____ - v. 13

A. They were traveling

1. On their way to Emmaus (which means "warm baths").
 - a. 7.5 miles away from Jerusalem
 - b. Why would they be leaving if Jesus has risen?

II. They reacted to the resurrection by _____ - vs. 14-15a

A. Reasoned about the right subject (Jesus)

1. Talked together - they talked reciprocally
2. Communed - to talk
3. Reasoned - examined, discussed, disputed and questioned together
 - a. Topics of conversation - vs. 19-24

B. Reasoning led to wrong conclusion

1. Hoping Jesus would "physically" redeem Israel.- v. 21

III. They reacted to the resurrection by missing the _____ Jesus- vs. 15b-16

A. Jesus drew near

1. Eyes were holden - to seize or take hold of
2. They did not recognize Jesus

IV. Jesus reacted to their reactions by rehearsing revelation - vs. 25-28.

A. The rebuke

1. Fools & slow of heart

B. The revelation - Jesus expounded the Scriptures

V. Resurrected Jesus should rekindle hearts - v. 32

A. Burning hearts

1. Hearts consumed with fire.
