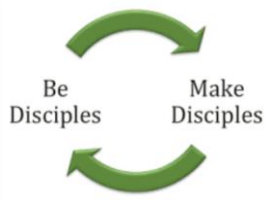
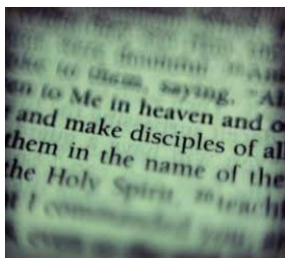

Paul penned, "For in him dwelleth all the fullness of the Godhead bodily, and ye are complete in him, which is the head of all principality and power (Col. 2:9-10).

The completeness of which Paul speaks is only located "in Him." One must be a Christian to fully comprehend and experience this completeness in Jesus. The only way to get into Christ is to be baptized into Christ (Gal. 3:26-27). This is why evangelism is so important. People are really missing the completeness of the Christian life.

How is life complete as a Christian? Paul warned those of Colosse to beware of those who will try to spoil their faith through philosophy, vain deceit, and the traditions of men. He wanted them to know that everything they needed to be complete was in Christ. There was no need to seek anything or anyone except Jesus. People today seek after these very things Paul mentioned. Philosophy is simply the love of wisdom. Vain deceit is teaching that is void of truth. There are the traditions of men which are a body of teachings devised by men and not by God. All of these are after the rudiments of the world and if heard, accepted, and practiced will not lead to the completeness that is only found in Jesus.

This shows the importance of our work as Christians. Guiding people through the word of God can allow individuals the opportunity to move away from philosophy, wisdom, and vain deceit which will not bring any completeness to the soul.
