Body:

 - A. Two sources indicate the truth of that statement.
 1. The revelation of nature — Ps. 19:1; Rom. 1:20.
 - a. One can see the power and the wisdom of God —
Ps. 104:24; Pr. 3:19-20.
 2. The revelation of God's word — Gen. 1:1; Mal. 2:10.
 - a. He is the eternal "I Am" — Exod 3:14-15; Ps. 90:2.
 - b. His Almighty Power was demonstrated —
Ps. 33:6, 9.
 3. Certainly it can be said — Rev. 4:11.
- II. He is Lord of heaven and earth — Rev. 19:6.
 - A. He is all-knowing — Ps. 33:13-15; Ps. 147:4-5.
 - B. He is all-powerful — Matt. 19:26.
 - C. He is free to exercise His will — Ps. 135:6.
 - D. David, before the throne was turned over to Solomon —
1 Chron. 29:11-13.
- III. He gives to all life, breath, and all things.
 - A. The life of man is a gift from God — Gen. 2:7.
 1. God is our Creator — Eccl. 12:1; Ps. 100:3.
 - B. He has given Spiritual life — 1 Jn. 4:9.
 - C. He is the giver of all things — Jas. 1:17; 2 Cor. 9:8.
